ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY

TGC Council wish to ensure that those playing the course are able to do so safely, and that they are not exposed to any unnecessary risks due to adverse weather conditions.

Therefore the following policy and rules will apply in the event of adverse weather:-

1. Competition Days

In the event that one or more Council Members present consider that the prevailing weather conditions present a risk to those participating or intending to participate in the Competition, that Council Member / those Council members is / are authorised to cancel the Competition and close the Course.

In the event no Council member is present and participants consider that the prevailing weather conditions present a risk to those participating or intending to participate in the Competition, contact should be made with one of the following:-

who will, based on the information provided, take the decision as to whether the Competition is to be cancelled and the Course closed.

In the event of the Competition being cancelled, entry fees will be refunded and a new date for the Competition will be scheduled.

Scores inputted into the Club V1 system prior to the cancellation of the Competition will be applied by Club V1 for handicap purposes in the normal manner.

2. General Play

In the event that the Greenkeeper or Assistant Greenkeeper consider that the prevailing weather conditions present a risk to those playing or intending to play on the Course, the Greenkeeper or Assistant Greenkeeper is authorised to close the Course.

In the event that the Greenkeeper or Assistant Greenkeeper is not present at the relevant time, the decision is to be taken by any Council member present.

In the event no Council member is present and a player considers that the prevailing weather conditions present a risk to those playing or intending to play on the Course, contact should be made with one of the following:-
